Dear Saints of the Most High God,

God's wonderful blessings to you in this precious new year. God has graciously given us another year to be fellow laborers in the harvest. His Kingdom shall have no end!

With this letter we wanted to express our deepest thanks for your love toward us and for what God has been doing in us during this last year. A quick snapshot of things that happened is revealing of God's heart for His people, especially in Africa. Here's what we got done (that we know of):

IN 2017 WE:

 Completed 15 Schools of Ministry for 2,329 pastors in Kenya (7 schools), Zambia (6 schools), Malawi (1 school), and Zimbabwe (1 school) with many additional pastors also traveling in from Burundi, DR Congo, Tanzania, Botswana, and Uganda.

All our students are functioning pastors. Their average church size is about 100 and many of them oversee multiple churches. It is common to find pastors overseeing as many as 50 (sometimes

over 100!) churches out in rural areas. They go village to village and across national borders to start them. We commissioned one additional KFMI instructor to make a total of four in Kenya and one in Zambia. More are in the pipeline (a two to 3 year training process). More instructors enables us to double and hopefully triple the schools we can do as the finances come in while at the same time lowering our



instructor-travel costs. More and more pastors are clamoring for a school in their area. This is God at work!

 Continued translations of KFMI books and training materials in French (for pastors in DR Congo, Burundi, and Rwanda) and in Bemba (for DR Congo and Zambia). We also are reviewing plans to start a translation center for Kiswahili (for Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, and Tanzania)

• Continued live "Skype" type of video broadcasts and social media outreach. Paul broadcasts into ongoing Schools of Ministry when internet is available, as well as a monthly web fellowship here in the US (first Mondays of each month). Even more exciting is a new monthly Saturday web fellowship for African pastors. The first one we did last year drew 588 pastors from six countries! They are so amazed that someone loves them enough to do such a thing to continue teaching them tools of the Holy Spirit they need to function in their churches. God is so good! Please plan to join

Keeping pastors connected is important in Africa because fellowship is so needed. For this purpose our Director for the work in Africa, Pastor John Amos has hit upon using WhatsApp to stay in close touch. So instantly when there is need for prayer, announcements of new schools and how to attend them, or short teachings from Pastor Paul or other pastors, each of thousands of pastors can get the message in moments. We praise God we can use these electronic tools for the Kingdom rather than the way the adversary uses them.

- Became incorporated as a non-profit foundation in Kenya which allows a legal status that enables much more work to be done, attracts more pastors (because the Kenya and other African nations are very concerned about homespun ministries without any Bible training certifications), and facilitates our work in other countries as well. We also moved the center of our operations to be closer to Nairobi airport to lower the costs of international travel. By God's grace and mercy, KFMI is now active in 14 African countries with more pastors requesting our schools each year. Africa shall be saved! We want to also underscore the fact that we are a parachurch ministry which comes alongside all denominations to teach and equip pastors. Because we have no members, we do not affiliate or ally with any churches. Hence denominations trust us enough to send us hundreds of their pastors each year to train and equip. God gives us wonderful favor to do this.
- Started free distribution of bi-monthly teachings on CD for all those who would like to have edifying, powerful teachings mailed to them once every two months. You can enjoy them in your car while traveling or at home. These are powerhouse exciting motivational teachings that you can enjoy and pass along. - Spend more time in His presence. We are realizing the amazing Kingdom productivity truth that the more time we spend resting in the presence of the Lord, ceasing from our work, the more God accomplishes through us. Because of this, and spearheaded by the many pastors working with us in Africa, we begin each year with forty days of prayer for the wisdom to set the schedule of KFMI schools for the new year. We confess, however, that we jumped the gun last month by already running a School of Ministry in January this year. Three hundred and twenty eight pastors gathered in Namanga (on the border between Kenya and Tanzania) for a school run by Pastor John Amos. It had been planned for early December last year but had to be postponed during the previously mentioned move of the KFMI office location nearer to Nairobi. Those Namanga pastors couldn't wait. They had been asking for a KFMI School of Ministry for the past two years!
- Post new language translations on the ministry website so more and more of our training materials can be
 freely accessed. All our foreign language translations are freely available for downloading, and we continue to
 get increasing requests for our schools in other countries, particularly India. We now have a Bemba translation
 center in Zambia, and will soon be starting one in Kenya for Kiswahili and its five surrounding Kiswahili-speaking
 countries.
- Complete the video processing of a new school in the Chichewa language for Malawi. Paul taught alongside two of our country directors (from Kenya and Zambia) this past February in the country of Malawi. In the last two years 263 pastors have graduated from our schools in that country, and more are expected when Paul returns to Malawi in this fall.
- Complete the video processing of a new school course in the Kiswahili language which was filmed with 30 senior pastors and bishops in Kenya last March. This course enabled them to interpret

tongues and operate the manifestation of prophecy. No one got missed. It was powerful! The school also

covered how to discern and guard against false prophetic utterances (which are rife in Africa), and presented the enormous power of words from the throne room. Oppositely, the destructive power of cursed words was taught especially as it enables witchcraft (which I hate and which African pastors deal with often).



• Commence Women's Ministry training for the thousands of women pastors in Kenya, Tanzania, Malawi, Mozambique and Uganda. Uganda has more women pastors than men. They are on fire and dearly long to be equipped for more effective fire-breathing Holy Ghost ministry. During the Fall trip to Malawi, Paul will run a special additional training in Malawi to recognize and empower women's ministry in Africa. This is

This is something that has just arisen in the past two weeks, and it is both very humbling and eye-opening to see the urgency with which God wants us to be out teaching. It also illustrates the love of so many presious saints who have jumped in to help.

People need to hear how to hear God's voice for themselves. They need to be encouraged to boldly operate in the supernatural as Kingdom builders. We are not getting older (as in heading for infirmity). God wants us to know instead that we are getting more spiritually enabled for the signs, miracles, and wonders Kingdom outreach that He wants to do through you in 2018!

• **Finally, our Annual Campfire Weekend dates** are set. Please mark your calendar for **September's 14-16** days of fun with God's Word around the campfire in the Berkshire Hills of Western Massachusetts. What a precious time of loving on God, and His loving on you with precious fellow believers in Christ. We look forward to being with you and enjoying the presence of God!

So these are just some of the doors which the Lord is helping us to walk though in the coming year. Let God arise, and His enemies be scattered! We are so grateful for the Lord Jesus Christ's anointing thought the Holy Spirit to continue to obey His direction to build His church His way and not our way.
